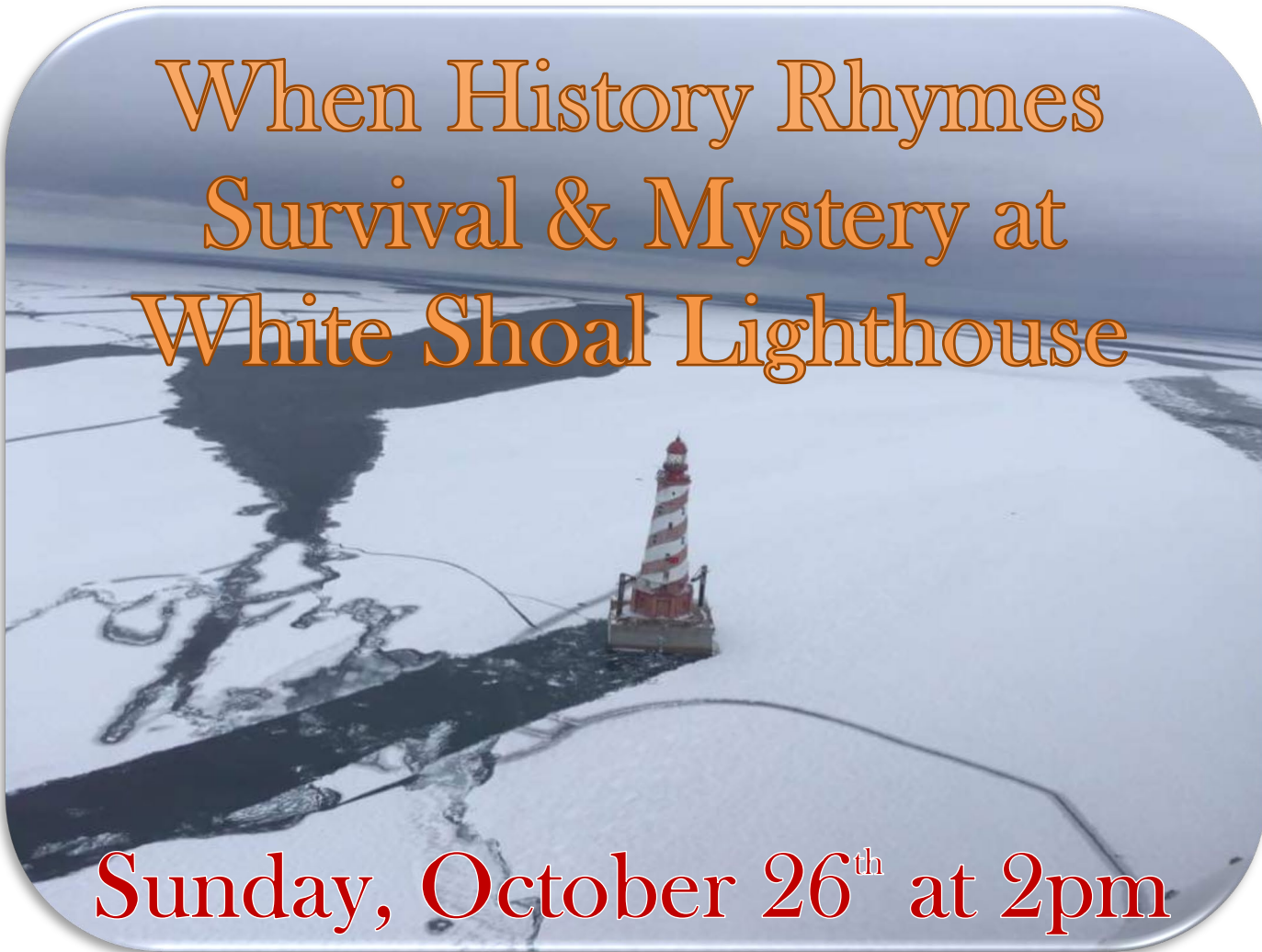




When History Rhymes Survival & Mystery at White Shoal Lighthouse
